Summary: Responsible for assigning gate passes, patrolling and protecting assigned premises, security and act as a visible deterrent against theft of vehicles, vehicle parts and the auction itself.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Assists gate passes with vehicles coming and going from lot, verifying VIN's and entering into ASI.
- 2. Close and lock front doors at assigned times in morning and evening.
- 3. Close and lock lot gates and other buildings each morning and evening.
- 4. Assist buyers of dealers with obtaining gate passes and locating vehicles.
- 5. Drives perimeter of lot and all lanes to always keep lot secure.
- 6. Communicate with manager of any problems that may arise.
- 7. Call emergency services or law enforcement if needed.
- 8. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required at Time of Hire:

- 1. Must be able to sit and remain alert while monitoring premises for a period of up to twelve hours.
- 2. Exceptional verbal and written communication skills; ability to express information clearly.
- 3. Conducts work in a timely manner, with the ability to prioritize; reduces inefficiencies and enhances effectiveness.
- 4. Ability to work independently as well as in a group setting.
- 5. Ability to troubleshoot problems, evaluate options and implement solutions.
